| :--- | :--- |
| Vowels | $a, e, \mathrm{i}, \mathrm{o}, \mathrm{u}$ <br> y at the end of a word |
| Long Vowel Silent-e | Long vowel silent-e words have 1 vowel, 1 consonant, <br> an e at the end, and the vowel sound is long. |

Here are some examples of words with the long vowel silent-e:
