Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus

Lesson 6

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with the vowel teams ***igh*** and ***oa***. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

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|--------------------|--|
| Consonants | b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word |
| Vowels | a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word |
| Vowel Teams | A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are pronounced as 1 vowel sound. |

Here are some examples of words with the vowel teams *igh* and *oa*:

| igh | | oa | |
|------------|-------|-----------|------|
| bright | might | croak | moan |
| fight | sight | goal | oak |
| flight | thigh | goat | road |
| light | tight | Joan | roam |
