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Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 7

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with the vowel teams $\boldsymbol{e} \boldsymbol{e}$ and oee. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

| Consonants | $b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z$ <br> $y$ at the beginning of a word |
| :--- | :--- |
| Vowels | $a, e, i, o, u$ <br> $y$ at the end of a word |
| Vowel Teams | A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are <br> pronounced as 1 vowel sound. |

Here are some examples of words with the vowel teams ee and oe:

| ee |  | oe |  |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| bee | feet | doe | Joe |
| beet | green | foe | Moe |
| cheek | keep | goes | toe |
| creek | need | hoe | woe |
