Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 8

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with the <u>vowel teams</u> <u>ai, ay, oi, and oy</u>. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

Consonants	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word	
Vowels	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word	
Vowel Teams	A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are pronounced as 1 vowel sound.	

Here are some examples of words with the vowel teams ai, ay, oi, and oy:

ai	ay	oi	oy
braid	day	coil	boy
fail	gray	foil	соу
pain	Jay	moist	ploy
rain	May	oil	toy
wait	tray	point	Troy
