In our classroom this week, we are reviewing how to read and spell words with predictable vowel teams. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

| Consonants | $b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, I, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z$ <br> $y$ at the beginning of a word |
| :--- | :--- |
| Vowels | $a, e, i, o, u$ <br> $y$ at the end of a word |
| Vowel Teams | A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are <br> pronounced as 1 vowel sound. |
