In our classroom this week, we are reviewing how to read and spell words with **predictable vowel teams**. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

Consonants	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word	
Vowels	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word	
Vowel Teams	A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are pronounced as 1 vowel sound.	

Here are some examples of words with predictable vowel teams:

creek	flight	coal	doe	bait
creep	high	coat	foe	pail
keep	night	oat	Roe	wait

ay	oi	оу	au	aw
day	coil	соу	haul	dawn
